"We recognize that sustainable urban development and management are crucial to the quality of life of our people. We will work with local authorities and communities to renew and plan our cities and human settlements so as to foster community cohesion and personal security and to stimulate innovation and employment."

2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, paragraph 34

Adapting, customizing and translating the SDGs into local development plans and strategies that fit the needs, context, and priorities of a particular region or locality, in coherence with national frameworks.

- Setting of goals and targets
- Determining the means of implementation
- Using indicators to measure and monitor progress
